The original Odyssey included a 2.2-liter four-cylinder engine with 140 horsepower and a four-engine transmission. Honda upgraded the engine to a 2.3-liter version with 150 horsepower in 1998 State Cars Direct.Unlike most other minivans on the market at the time, the rear doors of the Odyssey swung on loops like traditional car doors rather than sliding. The first generation Honda Odyssey can handle six or seven passengers comfortably and featured a four-cylinder engine with a four-speed transmission. Additional features included two glove boxes, an independent suspension and removable second row seats. Second generation: 1999 - 2004Motor Trend mentions that Honda produced the second generation Of Odyssey from 1999 to 2004. This updated iteration got engine power by turning off the original four-cylinder for the 3.5-liter V-6. Other major changes to the Odyssey included larger size and sliding doors on either side of the vehicle. Production of American models first moved to Canada from Japan, and then to Alabama halfway through the second generation. Around the time of the move from Canada to Alabama, Odyssey changed from a four-speed automatic transmission to a five-speed transmission. The second-generation odyssey has received much more than the first generation. The design of the door has gone from hinged to sliding, like a traditional minivan during this redesign. The size of the engine increased along with the body. The 3.5-liter six-cylinder engine with a 210-horsepower engine replaced the four-cylinder engine present in the first generation models. The original four-speed gearbox was standard for the first three years, but improved five-speed the 240-horsepower transmission debuted in 2002. Customers can choose from two trim levels: LX and EX. Both finishes offered seating for passengers, as well as sliding doors. It remained in production until the 2010 model year. In line with previous updates, this iteration has increased again in size. Additional features included additional second-row center jump seats to add passenger seats. This Odyssey could hold eight passengers. The 3.5-liter six-cylinder engine initially provided 255 horsepower, but has dropped to 244 horsepower since 2006. Ex and Touring finishes have got a Honda VCM, or variable cylinder control system that increased fuel efficiency, allowing the Odyssey to run on three, four or six cylinders as needed. In this iteration, the five-speed automatic transmission was standard for all kits. Four sets for the third generation of Odyssey included: LX, EX, EX-L and Touring. With eight seats and a second-row sliding seat, the cabin was much easier to navigate and adjust. Additional features included running-flat tires, rear lift-gate, memory seat, and adjustable pedals. Notable features unveiled in 2008 included: Side Curtain Airbag StandardCylinder deactivation for high trimsVoice-recognition navigationRepresented front-endFive-speed automaticFourth Generation: 2011 - 2017The fourth-generation Odyssey, which debuted in the 2011 model year, has received an updated exterior style, including the dynamic front grille, Autolist says. The base model received the same engine, a 3.5-liter V-6 with a five-speed automatic transmission, but the higher trim levels received a six-family automatic transmission. In 2014, the fourth-generation Odyssey was updated in the middle of the cycle, in which all trim levels provided a six-speed automatic transmission. The high-finish models also included a built-in vacuum cleaner. In 2014, Odyssey performed in the same way as Consent, with which Odyssey shared the platform. The onboard vacuum was hit and installed to reach all areas of the cockpit successfully. Honda significantly changed the look in 2011 with a lower roof line and a wider body. This generation also introduced a new, top finish, Touring Elite. With this edition, buyers could choose from five common finishes: LX, EX, EX-L, Touring, and Touring Elite.The top-end Touring and Touring Elite models provided a six-speed automatic transmission. Other trim levels continued with a five-speed automatic transmission. All Odyssey kits continued to use the 3.5-liter V-6 engine 248 horsepower. Honda has also added voice navigation to higher trim levels along with the XM Nav-traffic system. Fifth Generation: 2018 - PresentThe current Odyssey in the fifth generation. Updates for the 2018 model year Odyssey included a driver's choice of nine-speed or or Automatic transmission. Ten Speed was available for higher trim levels like Touring and Elite. The 3.5-liter six-cylinder engine improved and provided 280 horsepower, which is more than previous generations. As in previous generations, the current Odyssey comes in five trim levels. Presented at the Chicago Auto Show, the new Odyssey displayed on the Honda booth was presented as a concept, a typical ploy the manufacturer uses for the soon-to-be-introduced production model. Lending confidence in the production of the show car's readiness, insiders say the concept will be little different from the sales version that will appear in Honda showrooms this fall.
